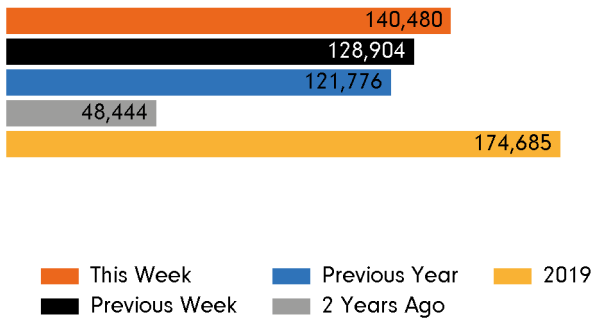

- The total number of visitors to Canterbury City Centre for the last 52 weeks is 7,626,181 which is 6.5% up on the previous year.
- The total number of visitors for the year to date is 394,456 which is 17.2% up on the previous year.
- The total number of visitors to Canterbury City Centre in week commencing 16 January 2023 was 140,480.
- The busiest day in week commencing 16 January 2023 was Saturday with 29,162 visitors.
- The peak hour of the week was 14:00 on Saturday 21 January 2023 with footfall of 3,231.

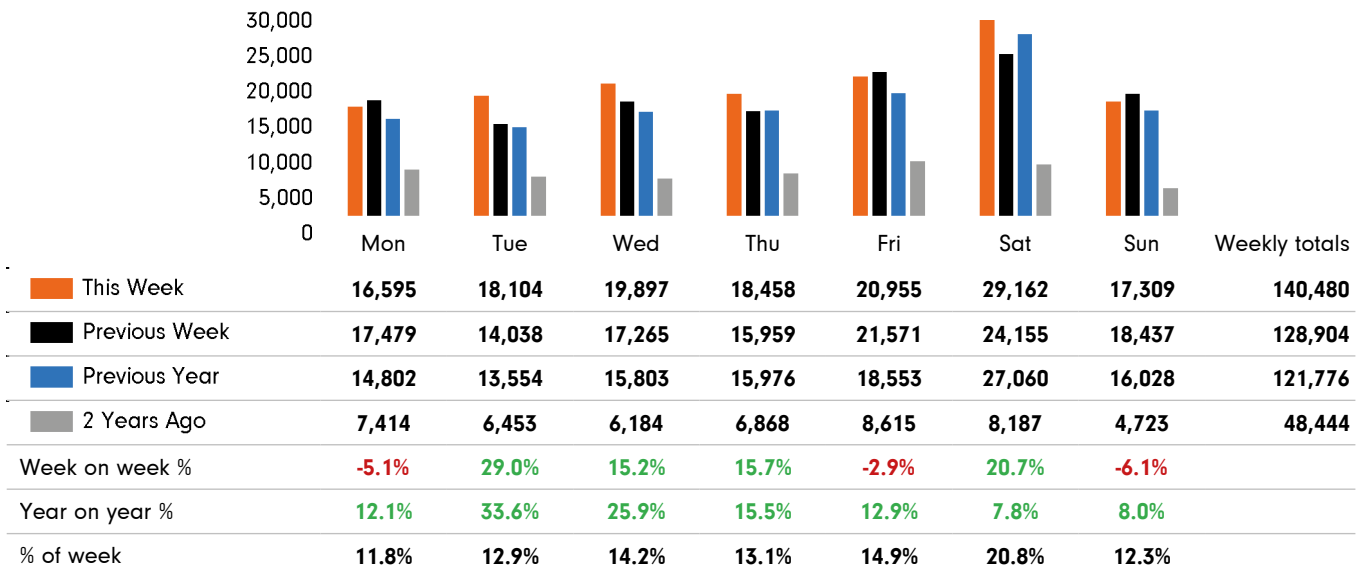

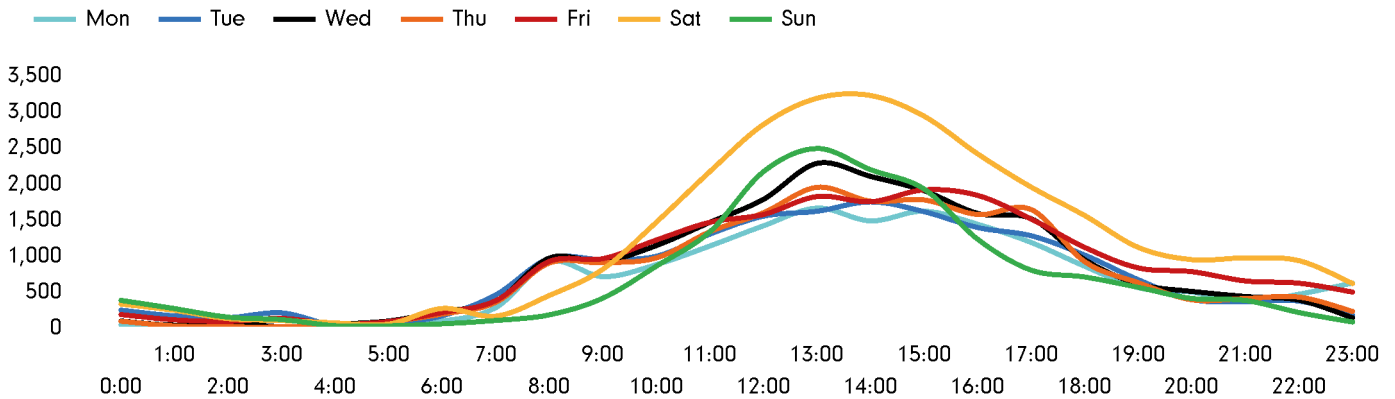

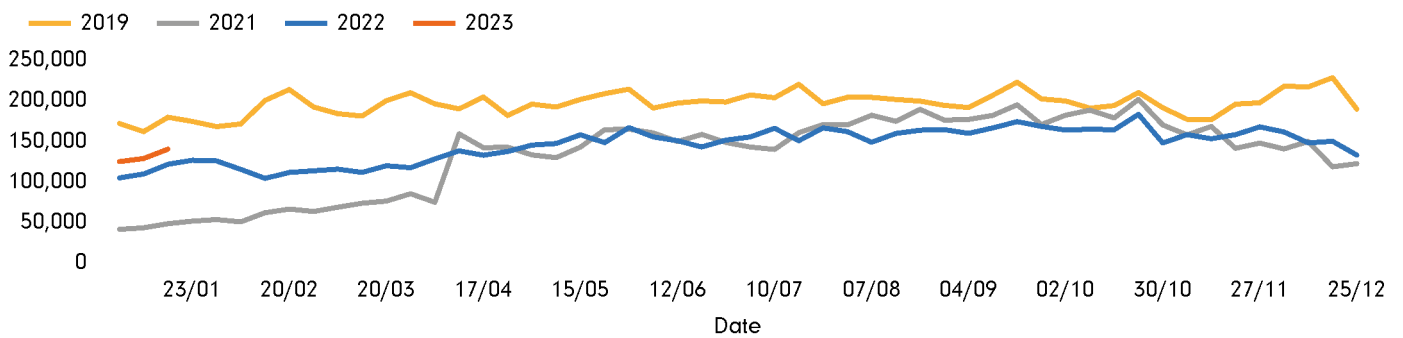
## Footfall by day



## Footfall by hour



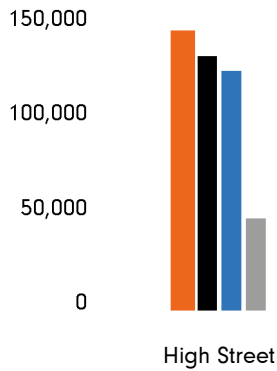

## 2019 comparison for Canterbury City Centre

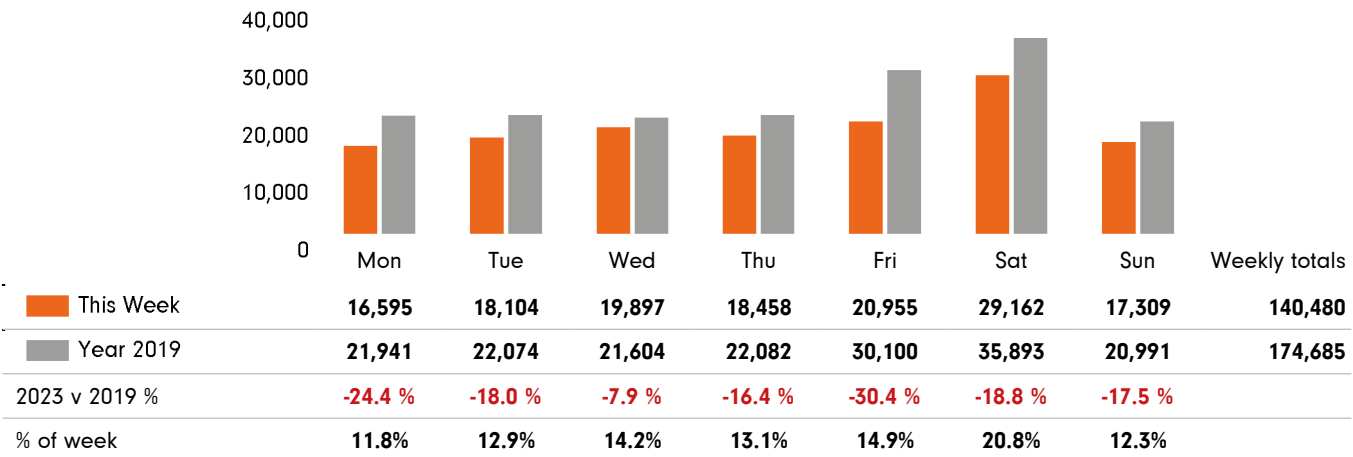
