The change in footfall for Canterbury City Centre over the last 52 weeks is 32.8% down on the previous year.


Footfall for the year to date is 44.8% down on the previous year.

The number of visitors counted for week commencing 31 August 2020 was 158,399.


The busiest day in week commencing 31 August 2020 was Saturday with 27,548 visitors.

The peak hour of the week was 14:00 on Monday 31 August 2020 with footfall of 3,479


# Footfall by week










## Footfall by hour
