The total number of visitors for the year to date is 2,657,419 which is 7.9% up on the previous year.


The total number of visitors to Canterbury City Centre in month commencing 31 May 2021 was 782,666.

The busiest day in month commencing 31 May 2021 was Saturday 26 June with 32,902 visitors.

The peak hour of the month was 14:00 on Saturday 19 June 2021 with footfall of 3,213.




#### Footfall by day


#### Footfall by hour

#### Footfall - rolling 12 months




#### Footfall by week of month


