## Headlines

The total number of visitors to Canterbury City Centre for the last 52 weeks is 6,395,694 which is 4.5% down on the previous year.

The total number of visitors for the year to date is 5,642,664 which is 14.9% up on the previous year.

The total number of visitors to Canterbury City Centre in week commencing 25 October 2021 was 201,863.

The busiest day in week commencing 25 October 2021 was Saturday with 35,475 visitors.






















The peak hour of the week was 14:00 on Saturday 30 October 2021 with footfall of 3,758.

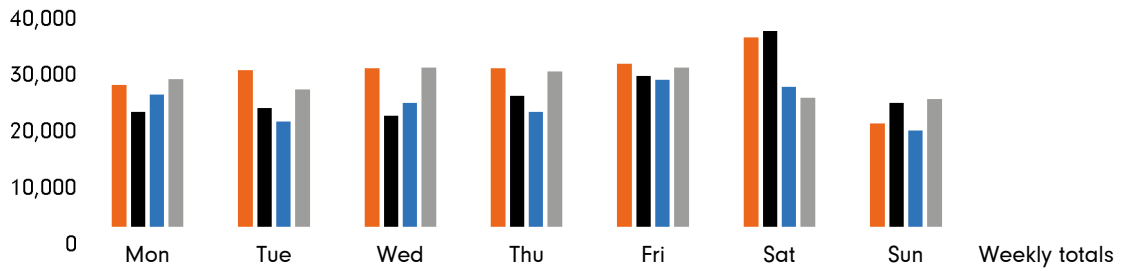

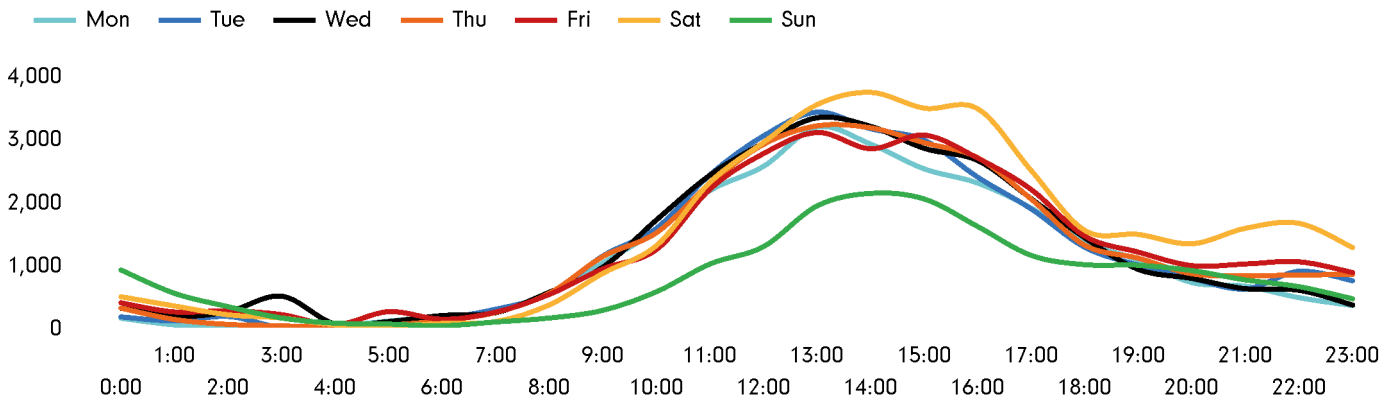

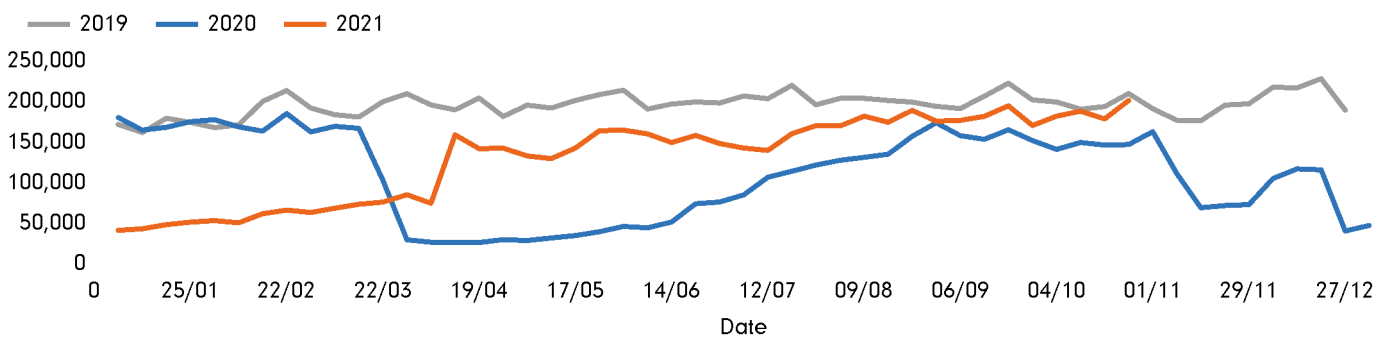

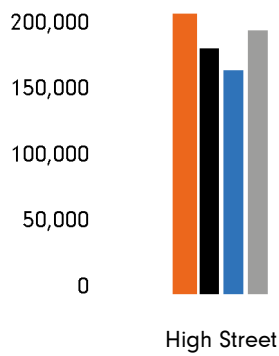

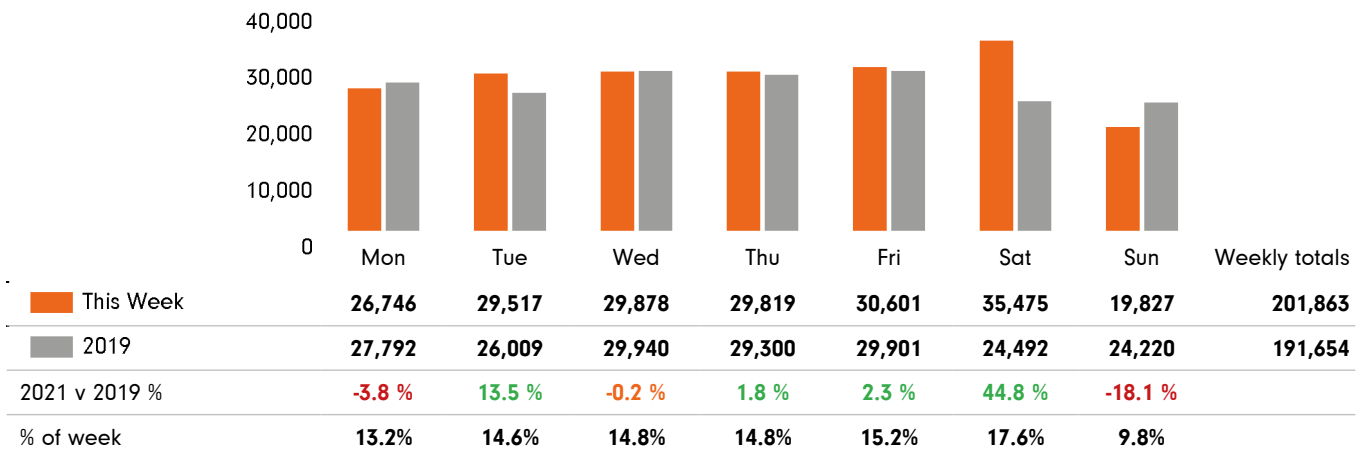
