The total number of visitors to Canterbury City Centre for the last 52 weeks is 7,090,674 which is 30.9% up on the previous year.


The total number of visitors for the year to date is 214,730 which is 153.4% up on the previous year.

The total number of visitors to Canterbury City Centre in week commencing 10 January 2022 was 109,792.


The busiest day in week commencing 10 January 2022 was Saturday with 23,175 visitors.

The peak hour of the week was 14:00 on Saturday 15 January 2022 with footfall of 2,886.











Footfall by hour


