The total number of visitors for the year to date is 2,036,424 which is 56.2% up on the previous year.

The total number of visitors to Canterbury City Centre in month commencing 4 April 2022 was 537,130.

The busiest day in month commencing 4 April 2022 was Saturday 23 April with 26,153 visitors.

The peak hour of the month was 12:00 on Saturday 23 April 2022 with footfall of 2,784.








Footfall by hour






