The total number of visitors for the year to date is 3,404,239 which is 28.1% up on the previous year.


The total number of visitors to Canterbury City Centre in month commencing 30 May 2022 was 768,256.




Footfall by day


Footfall by hour

Footfall - rolling 12 months




Footfall by week of month




Footfall by day
