Make a dragon hat or costume for the Canterbury Medieval Pageant Parade!

1

Ask an adult to help.

2

Find a baseball cap. Recycle one if you can!

3

Make dragon eyes from felt, foam or a similar material and stick them firmly to the side of the baseball cap, slightly nearer the front, using sticky Velcro spots (excellent and no mess) or glue.

4

Cut teeth from a strip of card or thin pliable plastic (washed, cut-up milk containers are brilliant) and stick around the underside rim of the peak of the baseball cap. Cut the ends off the teeth so they're not too sharp.

5

Attach ears to the top of the cap, using sticky Velcro spots. These can be made from recycled pliable plastic or card (sections of a cut-up Pringles/crisps tube works extremely well).

6

Add a forked tongue.

Make a zig-zag spine to attach to the back of your baseball cap (secured around strip that adjusts the cap).

To make a complete outfit, find a plain white or light-coloured t-shirt and use fabric pens, fabric paints or cut-out felt scales to create a scaly body.

9

Use colourful, gauzy fabric for dragon wings.

Try on your costume and roar like a dragon... ready to join the parade!
