#### **Headlines**


The total number of visitors for the year to date is 6,438,557 which is 16.8% up on the previous year.

The total number of visitors to Canterbury City Centre in month commencing 28 August 2023 was 889,260.

The busiest day in month commencing 28 August 2023 was Saturday 30 September with 34,893 visitors.

The peak hour of the month was 14:00 on Saturday 30 September 2023 with footfall of 3,354.




#### Footfall Counts by day


#### Footfall Counts by hour

#### Footfall Counts - rolling 12 months




#### Footfall Counts by week of month




#### Footfall Counts by day
