The total number of visitors to Canterbury City Centre for the last 52 weeks is 8,427,929 which is 12.6% up on the previous year.


The total number of visitors for the year to date is 7,355,320 which is 13.2% up on the previous year.

The total number of visitors to Canterbury City Centre in week commencing 6 November 2023 was 144,492.


The busiest day in week commencing 6 November 2023 was Saturday with 28,145 visitors.









Footfall Counts by day




Footfall Counts by hour


