The total number of visitors to Canterbury City Centre for the last 52 weeks is 8,475,456 which is 11.7% up on the previous year.


The total number of visitors for the year to date is 135,339 which is 8.2% up on the previous year.

The total number of visitors to Canterbury City Centre in week commencing 1 January 2024 was 135,339.


The busiest day in week commencing 1 January 2024 was Saturday with 28,079 visitors.

The peak hour of the week was 14:00 on Saturday 6 January 2024 with footfall of 3,227.


#### Footfall Counts by week











#### Footfall Counts by hour

# 2019 comparison for Canterbury City Centre


