The total number of visitors to Canterbury City Centre for the last 52 weeks is 8,465,189 which is 11.9% up on the previous year.


The total number of visitors for the year to date is 8,465,189 which is 11.9% up on the previous year.

The total number of visitors to Canterbury City Centre in week commencing 25 December 2023 was 156,253.


The busiest day in week commencing 25 December 2023 was Friday with 31,124 visitors.









#### Footfall Counts by day




#### Footfall Counts by hour

## 2019 comparison for Canterbury City Centre


